

2019 Makineni Lectureship - Call for Nominations

Endowed by PolyPeptide Laboratories and Murray and Zelda Goodman (2003)

The 2019 Makineni Lectureship recognizes an individual who has made a recent (within 2 years of the nomination deadline) contribution of unusual merit to research in the field of peptide science and who is recognized as an accomplished speaker. This award is intended to recognize original and singular discoveries rather than cumulative or lifetime contributions.

The 2019 Makineni Lecture will be delivered at the 26th American Peptide Symposium in Monterey California, in June 2019. The awardee must be able to attend the American Peptide Symposium in June 2019.

Nominations for the Makineni Lectureship should include the following items, assembled into a single PDF file:

1. A letter of nomination describing the candidate's outstanding contribution from the past two years (1,000 word limit; self-nominations are welcome).
2. A copy of the publication(s) describing the outstanding contribution.

Nominating documents should be submitted by **December 15, 2018**.
