2023 Vincent du Vigneaud Awards

The 2023 Vincent du Vigneaud Awards for outstanding achievement in peptide research will be presented to two recipients at the 28th American Peptide Symposium in Scottsdale, Arizona in June 2023. These Awards are intended to recognize scientific excellence at mid-career.

Nominations for the du Vigneaud Award should include the following items, assembled into a single PDF file.

1. A letter of nomination from the primary nominator (1,000 word limit).
2. The nominee's Curriculum Vitae and list of publications.
3. Up to three scientific papers authored by the nominee.
4. One additional ('seconding') letter (500 word limit).

Nominating documents should be submitted by **Friday, September 16th, 2022**.

Nominations for the 2021 Vincent du Vigneaud Award will be reviewed for a second time, but it is preferred that these nominations be updated. Award winners must be able to attend the American Peptide Symposium planned for June 24-29, 2023.
